

LE ONLY- Tactical Rifle Applications

This 2-day tactical rifle applications course is designed to provide participants with the information and ability necessary to become proficient with the use and demands of the tactical rifle. This course is demanding and fast-paced. It covers intermediate tactical processes; including, line-based and movement exercises, select fire positions, and bounding exercises.

At the completion of this training, the students will be versed in the following subjects giving them the confidence to safely and successfully deploy their department-issued semi-automatic, AR platform rifle systems.

Necessary Equipment:

Rifle (w/ light), rifle sling (mandatory), duty handgun, duty rig with holster and magazine pouches, 3 handgun magazines (4 if using single stack .45 magazines), 3 rifle magazines, (4 if issued 20 round capacity), common patrol or tactical equipment, including vest (w/ plates, helmet), knee and elbow pads, suitable clothing for all weather conditions, handheld flashlight, wrap-around eye protection (clear lenses for low light operation), ear protection, gloves, snacks, water, sunblock, and insect repellent.
